New applications are only being taken until February 28th.

Just ***ANOTHER*** reminder about parking, dismissal, and safety. Parents - please make sure you are parking in an appropriate spot for pickup. This includes all pick-ups - sports, play, art club, etc. Please DO NOT park on the sidewalk next to McNulty. It is a fire lane and it becomes a safety hazard when people park there. If you are ever in need of special education services, then you would also register in the Ken-Ton district. If you have questions, please let me know. Most of you are registered in your home districts, but students coming up from PK may not be.
